Duties

- Creating hands on developmentally appropriate activities to enhance challenging areas of each child.
- Light housekeeping- washing child dishes, sweeping, organizing, sanitizing toys, eating, and play areas.
- Communicate regularly with parents by providing documentation such as pictures/videos of each activity, meals, diaper changes/potty breaks, naps, sleep checks, and observations (when needed) each time of service (full or part time).
- Use critical thinking skills to handle a variety of situations during time of service (in emergencies or otherwise)
- Participate in meet and greet/parent teacher conference virtual zoom calls
- Have fun and be safe while doing it!

- Must have true passion to educate children
- Must be at least vaccinated (including booster shot)

- At least 18 years old
- Must undergo a full fingerprinting background check
- Must demonstrate experience working with children
- Must have reliable transportation
